

Changeling (1957)

Overview

Changeling, choreographed and performed by Merce Cunningham, with costumes and lighting by Rauschenberg and music by Christian Wolff, was first premiered at the Brooklyn Academy of Music, November 30, 1957. The documentation available here was filmed in 1958 at Norddeutscher Rundfunk Studio Hamburg (NDR).

There is an additional brief clip from a separate documentation of the work in the 1964 film *Merce Cunningham*, directed by Jackie Raynal with Etienne Becker, and Patrice Wyers.
