

Glacial Decoy (1979)

Overview

Glacial Decoy, choreographed by Trisha Brown, with sets and costumes by Robert Rauschenberg, was first presented by the Trisha Brown Dance Company at the Walker Art Center in Minneapolis, MN, May 7, 1979.

There isn't a complete filmed version of the work available at the RRF archives. The footage consists of various excerpts derived from the same performance of the work at the University of California, Berkeley in 1993.
