

Night Wandering (1958)

Overview

Night Wandering, choreographed by Merce Cunningham, originally premiered at the Kungl Teatern, Stockholm, Sweden, October 5, 1958, with costumes by Nicola Cernovich and music by Bo Nilsson. Rauschenberg designed new costumes in 1960, and these are featured in the excerpts referenced below. A complete film version of the work was shot by Sveriges Radio Televisionen in 1964. Performers included Merce Cunningham and Carolyn Brown.

There is also brief excerpt footage from another filming of the work (performance location unidentified) included in the compilation created by the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum as part of *Robert Rauschenberg Performance 1954 to 1995*.
