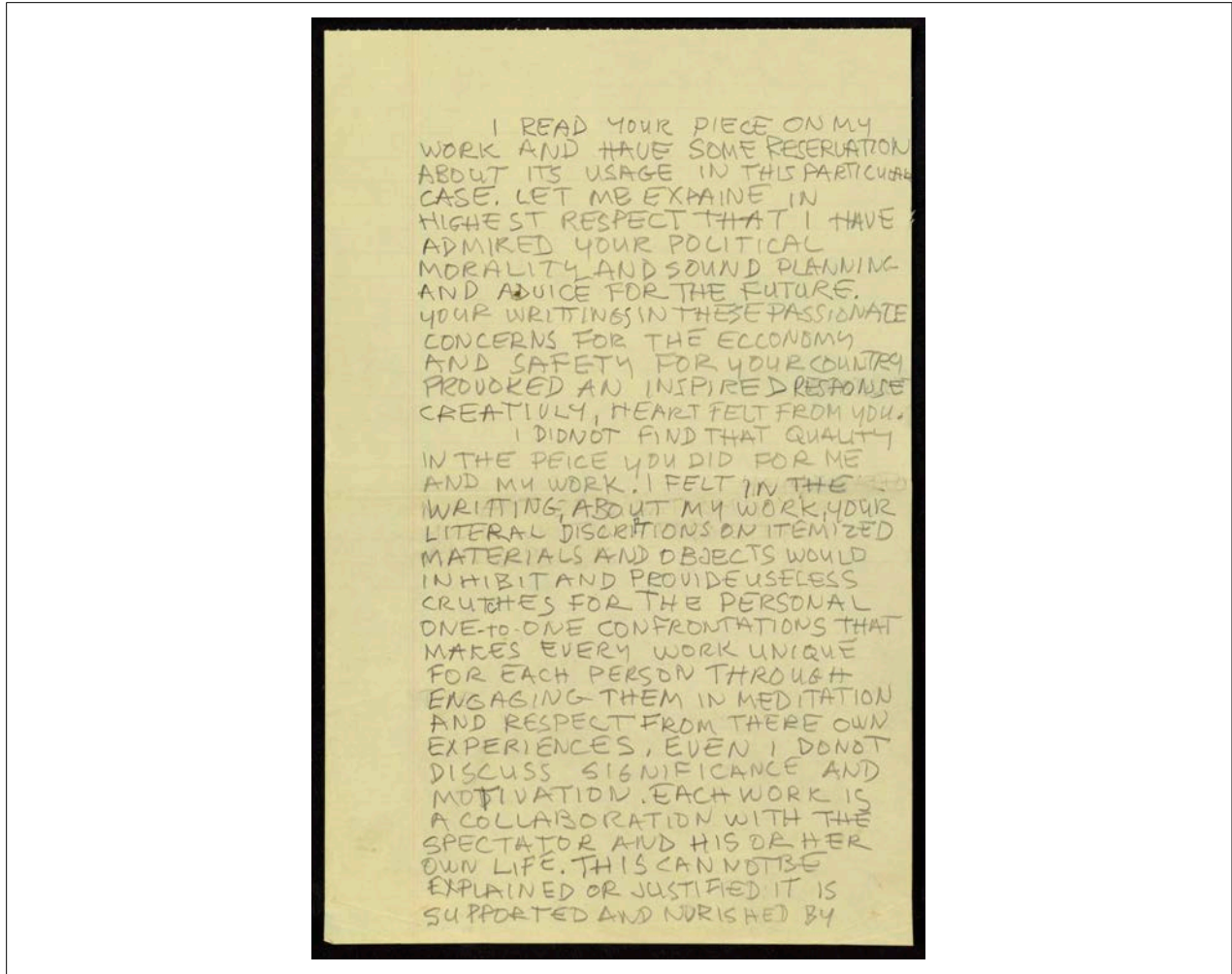

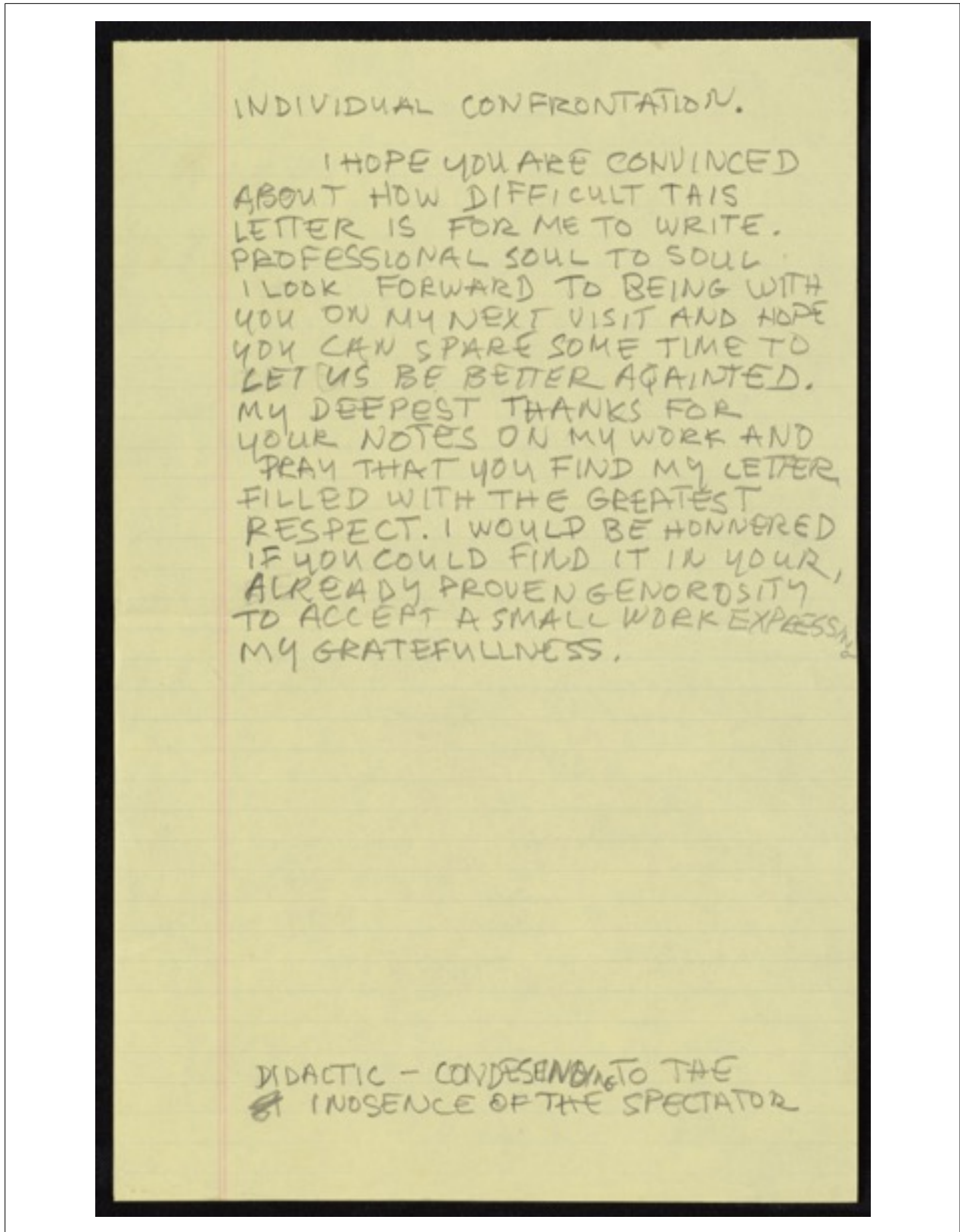

RAUSCHENBERG SCHEDULE IN CARACAS

09/09/85: Arrive from Miami on Pan Am #445 at 5:05 P.M.

Marilyn M. wanted to know if Bob would care to meet with Dr. Galloway that evening upon Dr. G's arrival from Germany. Bradley said absolutely no but this has not been relayed to Marilyn.

Bob will go directly to the museum to work on the show.

09/10/85: Bob indicated he would have lunch with Sofia Imber if the exhibit is in good shape.

Informal meeting with TV reporters is still on hold for the afternoon, no specific time scheduled. M.M. said they just needed a few individual statements from him which would go with stories they will do.

Working dinner at Marilyn's. You and/or TVB were invited. TVB does not wish to go. There will be members of Marilyn's staff, curator and others from the museum.

Bob granted permission for Dr. Galloway to go through the museum this morning.

09/11/85: Press conference at 11:00 A.M.

Interview with Galloway for "Die Zeit" at noon.

Reception at 8 P.M. given by the Charge (sp?) d'Affairs, Kim and wife, Caroline, Flower.

09/12/85: Opening at 8 P.M.

09/13/85: Meeting with students at the museum at 4 P.M.

Notes: No exclusive interviews set up yet. Marilyn recommends the following newspapers - "El Universal" (centrist paper of record), "El Nacional" - leftist daily. Also, Sofia is attempting to get front page color photo on "El Diario de Caracas" (centrist) which is geared more toward business and economics. There is an English language daily which Marilyn does not particularly recommend.

Still attempting to work out some kind of pre-taping session for Sofia and Carlos' show, "Buenos Dias, Venezuela."
