

Travelogue (1977)

Overview

Travelogue, choreographed by Merce Cunningham, with sets, costumes, and props by Robert Rauschenberg and music by John Cage was first presented by the Merce Cunningham Dance Company at the Minskoff Theatre, New York, NY, January 18, 1977.

There isn't a single comprehensive film version of the entire work. All excerpts here derive from the same performance footage made for the documentary program Merce Cunningham (1980), produced by London Weekend Television as part of The South Bank Show.
